General Equipment List and use in sessions

The following items will be required on Induction day.

- Note book
- Pen/Pencil
- Eraser
- Ruler
- Certificates/evidence of qualifications previously achieved including all essential skills

Art and Design subjects can be very expensive.

While we can provide some materials it is inevitable that you will need more.

The following is a list of general equipment that you need for your course, you will also need to buy specialist materials and equipment depending on which pathway you follow as the course progresses.

You are advised not to invest in elaborate equipment and materials not listed below without discussing with staff. The college cannot accept responsibility for loss of personal equipment, and therefore it is advisable to mark all items with your name.

All artists, designers and media creative's require appropriate 'tools' to work with. Similarly, you are required to bring the right materials and equipment to your classes.

This is considered appropriate professional practice and if equipment or materials are persistently forgotten, disciplinary action may be taken.

Art and Design –Textiles, 3D Design, Graphics, Fine Art and Art, Craft and Design and Photography.

This is a basic list all needed for the start of the course

- Notebook
- Black Fine liner Pens
- Range of Pencils
- Rubber
- Glue Stick
- Masking tape
- Ruler
- Coloured Pencils
- Sharpener
- Scissors
- A3 Sketchbook
- Range of brushes

The department has a good number of both digital and traditional SLR'S to facilitate learner progress, however access to a 35mm FSLR or DSLR will allow you to refine technical skills and develop your ideas. If you are thinking of buying a camera, please speak to your lecturer for advice.

Please note that in addition you are asked to pay a workshop fee of £15 (per AS/A2 Art & Design endorsement you study). The workshop fee is to cover some specialist materials that you will be supplied with and use/loan of specialist equipment resources.

You will also need to pay for any extra curricula visits linked to your course; both will need to be paid for through the online Wisepay system via the college website.
