General Equipment List

The following items will be required on Induction day.

- Note book
- Pen & Pencil
- Eraser
- Ruler
- Certificates/evidence of qualifications previously achieved.

Art and Design materials can be very expensive.

While we do provide most materials, you will however need your own to do work both in and outside of college.

The following is a general list that you must have to enable you to do your course. You may also need to some buy specialist materials and equipment. You are advised not to invest in elaborate equipment and materials, which are not listed below without discussing this first with staff. The college cannot accept responsibility for loss of personal equipment, and therefore it is advisable to mark all items with your name.

The following items will be required for the course.

The following is a basic list and further items will be required to be purchased as the course progresses. All artists, designers and media creative's require appropriate 'tools' to work with. Similarly, you are required to bring the right materials and equipment to your sessions. This is considered appropriate professional practice and if equipment or materials are persistently forgotten disciplinary action may be taken.

- Range of pencils from 8B to HB
- Pack of coloured pencils
- Range of paint brushes
- Range of soft and hard rubbers
- Black fine liners
- 1 pair of rubber gloves
- Glue Sticks
- Small A5 Note Book
- 1 x A4 ring binder files
- A4 Plastic Sleeves
- 1 x A3/A2 Clear plastic folders /A3/2 Sketch book
- 1 x A2 Polyholdall

The department has a good number of both digital and traditional SLR'S to facilitate learner progress, however access to a 35mm FSLR or DSLR will allow you to refine technical skills and develop your ideas. If you are thinking of buying a camera, please speak to our photographic technician for advice.

Please note that in addition you are asked to pay a workshop fee of £60. The workshop fee is to cover some specialist materials that you will be supplied with and use/loan of specialist equipment resources. You will also need to pay for any extra curricula visits linked to your course; both will need to be paid for through the online Wisepay system via the college website.
