



JOIN AS A SOLDIER

 AGES 16-17




ARMY FOUNDATION COLLEGE HARROGATE

-  23 or 49 weeks, with intakes in March and September each year.
-  Get paid £800-£1,000 a month.

If you're 16 or 17 you'll train at AFC Harrogate as a junior soldier. You'll learn all the skills you need, from map reading to how to handle a weapon. After Harrogate, you will do your Trade Training before joining your unit.

 AGES 17.5 AND OVER

BASIC TRAINING

-  ATR Winchester, ATR Pirbright **14 Weeks Training.**
-  ITC Catterick **26-28 Weeks Training.**
-  Annual salary – starting from over **£15,600** rising to over **£20,000** after 26 weeks' training.

INITIAL SOLDIER (BASIC) TRAINING

Here, you will learn the skills to become a soldier. The length of your Basic Training depends which part of the Army you join. While there, you'll have 'down time' including time for sport and adventure training and some time off to go home.

STUDENT NURSE

Study Nursing As a Soldier

Once you've finished Basic Training, you'll then complete a BSc (Hons) in Adult or Mental Health Nursing at Birmingham City University. Not only will your tuition **fees be paid by the Army**, but you'll earn a salary of over £21,000 whilst you study.

Or you can study nursing as a civilian and receive a bursary worth up to £42,000.



* The requirements for joining as a soldier vary from no qualifications to degree-level, depending on your role.

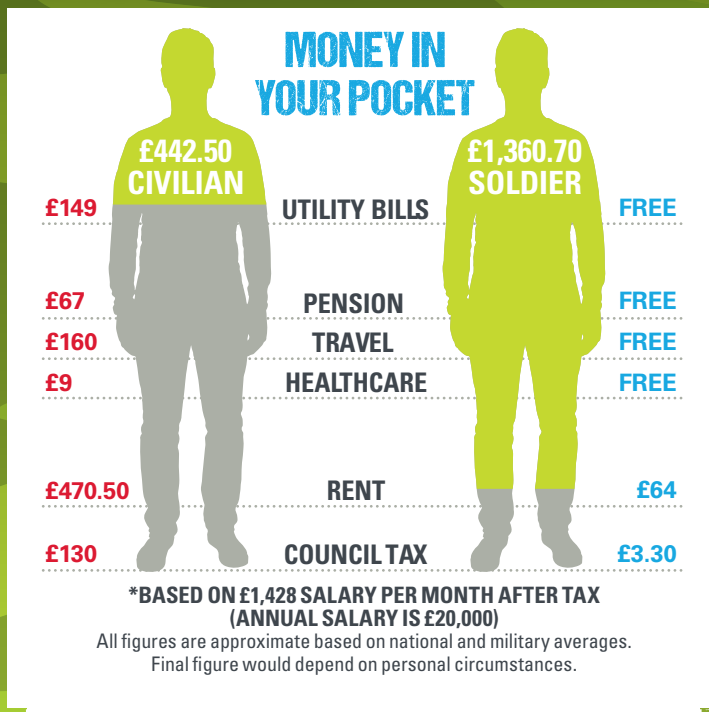

LOCAL COLLEGE OR SIXTH FORM

ARMY SIXTH FORM SCHOLARSHIP

Available to those studying two years of further education at school or college, wishing to join the Army as an Officer. You could receive **£3,000** paid in full in Year 13 (Upper Sixth Form, S6).

ARMY GAP YEAR COMMISSION

Experience the role of an Army Officer whilst on a gap year before university. After completion of an 8-week Army Reserve Commissioning Course, it's an 'internship' with no commitment after the GYC if so desired. The salary is around **£18,000**.

UNIVERSITY

ARMY UNDERGRADUATE BURSARY (STANDARD)

£6,000 for students on three year degree courses, or **£7,000** on four year degree courses.

ARMY UNDERGRADUATE BURSARY (TECHNICAL)

£25,000 for students wishing to commission into a Technical Corps with an engineering/science degree.

44-WEEK COMMISSIONING COURSE



ANNUAL SALARY STARTING FROM **OVER £27,200**, RISING TO **OVER £32,700** UPON COMMISSIONING.

STEM UNDERGRADUATE SPONSORSHIP

The scheme is expected to cover 3 years university tuition fees, plus an annual bursary and a lump sum upon completion of Officer training. Applications open in 2021

FULLY FUNDED DEGREE

Instead of heading off to university, you could gain a degree whilst you serve. Your training at Sandhurst counts towards a BSc in Leadership and Strategic Studies, offered by the University of Reading's Henley Business School. You'll carry on with your studies as your career continues beyond the Academy and you will not have to pay any fees.

ARMY UNDERGRADUATE BURSARY (ENHANCED)

£24,000 for students with high grade A-Levels, score well at AOSB, and achieve a 2:1 degree or higher.

PROFESSIONALLY QUALIFIED OFFICER (PQO) BURSARY

Up to **£75,000** available for students at Medical School, as potential Medical, Dental, Veterinary and Nursing Officers.

The Royal Military Academy Sandhurst in Surrey is where all officers in the British Army are trained to take on the responsibilities of leading the soldiers under their command. The Commissioning Course covers military skills and practical and academic subjects whilst developing your leadership skills.



AND MANY MORE

*The educational requirements for joining as an officer are: 35 ALIS points at GCSE (34 ALIS points for SNQs) and 72 UCAS points at A level (or equivalent).
