FUND YOUR EDUCATION



APPLY TO BE AN ARMY OFFICER

If you are thinking about joining the Army as an officer, there are opportunities for you to gain funding while you study.

ARMY SIXTH FORM SCHOLARSHIP

Receive £3,000 and a university bursary. Apply September to February in Year 12/S5/lower sixth (NI).

ARMY GAP YEAR COMMISSION

A paid 'internship' with no commitment to join afterwards and a salary from £18,000. Apply September to December in Year 13/S6/upper sixth (NI).

ARMY UNDERGRADUATE BURSARY

BURSARIES for study at university up to £25,000. MEDICAL BURSARIES up to £75,000 available for students as potential Doctor, Dental, Veterinary and Nursing Officers.

FULLY FUNDED DEGREE

Officer training at Royal Military Academy Sandhurst can count towards an Army funded degree in Leadership and Strategic Studies, offered by the University of Reading's Henley Business School.

HOT OFF THE PRESS! STEM UNDERGRADUATE SPONSORSHIP

Applications open from 2021 and it is expected to cover 3 years of university tuition fees *plus* an annual bursary and a lump sum on completing training.

APPLY TO BE A SOLDIER
